ORDINANCE NO. **21-11**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 191.06(a)(1) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF SHEFFIELD LAKE REGARDING EARNED INCOME TAX COLLECTION AT SOURCE, AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Sheffield Lake approved a one-quarter of one percent increase in the income tax rate with the effective date of July 1, 2006; and,

WHEREAS, Sheffield Lake City Council passed Ordinance 16-06 increasing the income tax rate by one-fourth of one percent; and,

WHEREAS, Section 191.06(a)(1) is inconsistent with Section 191.03 of the Code; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio to amend Section 191.06(a)(1) of the Codified Ordinances regarding Earned Income Tax Collection at Source.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Sheffield Lake, State of Ohio:

Section 1. Codified Ordinance 191.06(a)(1) presently reading as follows:

- (a) (1) Each employer within or doing business within the City who employs one or more persons on a salary, wage, commission or other compensation basis shall, at the time of payment thereof, deduct the tax of one percent from the gross salaries, wages, commissions or other compensation earned by City residents regardless of where such compensation was earned and shall deduct the tax of one percent from the salaries , wages, commissions or other compensation earned within the City by nonresidents.

Section 2. Is hereby amended as follows:

- (a) (1) Each employer within or doing business within the City who employs one or more persons on a salary, wage, commission or other compensation basis shall, at the time of payment thereof, deduct the tax imposed under Section 191.03 from the gross salaries, wages, commissions or other compensation earned by City residents regardless of where such compensation was earned and shall deduct the tax imposed under Section 191.03 from the salaries , wages, commissions or other compensation earned within the City by nonresidents.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of amending Section 191.06(a)(1) of the Codified Ordinances regarding Earned Income Tax Collection at Source.
