ORDINANCE NO. **54-11**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 935.17 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD LAKE REGARDING PAYMENT PLACE FOR WATER ACCOUNTS AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY.

*WHEREAS*, Chapter 935.17 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Sheffield Lake was adopted in 1971; and,

*WHEREAS*, Chapter 935.17 is outdated and obsolete; and,

*WHEREAS*, it is in the best interest of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio to repeal Chapter 935.17 of the Codified Ordinances regarding payment place.

*NOW THEREFORE*, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Sheffield Lake, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

Section 1. Codified Ordinance **935.17** presently reading as follows:

***935.17 PAYMENT PLACE.***

- (a) All payments shall be made to the Clerk of the Department of Public Service at her office, except as provided in subsection (b) hereof.
- (b) The Central Security National Bank of Lorain County, Sheffield Lake branch, is hereby authorized to collect and receive payments from the citizens and residents of the City and any others who are responsible for the payment of water bills due and owing to the City.
- (c) The City shall pay to the Central Security National Bank of Lorain County, Sheffield Lake branch, the sum of five cents (5¢) per bill for each and every bill collected by the Central Security National Bank of Lorain County, Sheffield Lake branch.
- (d) The Bank shall deposit all proceeds collected by it pursuant to this subsection into the account of the City and shall from time to time as agreed upon by the Service Director and the Bank notify the City as to the amount collected.

Section 2. Is hereby rewritten as follows:

All payments shall be made to the office of the Clerk of the Department of Public Service.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of clarifying the payment procedure for water accounts in the city.
