MAYORS REPORT: Mayor Bring reported I made a copy of a letter that a gentleman sent me and I gave it to all of you and just something for you to read because occasionally I get these and it was addressed to Council members too. Just some of the concerns of what people have in this city and if you read that it does make sense but unfortunately there is not we can do about rental properties, apartments and some of the other things. We are not actively pursuing any more of those but what he is saying about the tax dollars and everything does make complete sense. If you look at the little PS in the bottom there even though he was complaining about a few things he did vote for the levy. If you have noticed the police boat is no longer outside of our facility here, it has been picked up and that is going to be I think donated by Amvets to VFW and they are going to raffle that off. The gentleman that bought Abbe Road Lumber was in today talking to Mr. Wiblin, they are going to start renovating the place. So that should be looking a lot better here pretty soon. They are going to make that a training center for heating and cooling. So they are going to dress that place up and make it look nice. I know it has been in disarray and we sent them a little letter kind of address that but I didn't want to get too pushy because he is going to put a lot of money into the place. *Motion by Stark/Second by Elliott to accept the report. Yeas All./FINANCE DIRECTORS REPORT: None./TREASURER REPORT: report attached./SERVICE DIRECTORS REPORT: None./SAFETY DIRECTORS **REPORT:** Mayor Bring reported we had car#726 went down with a transmission problem, we are going to get that checked out. There was some questions asked about Community Days, we did have a Safety meeting about manning that. We are going to man that and I guess there was some questions about where did we find all the money for all that. Most of that manpower is going to be people who are already on duty, we do have a couple extra Officers but with that large of an event we cannot take a chance of having something go wrong so we are paying a couple extra people to go there. The ambulance that we usually have down at the park all the time is going to be there as long as they don't have a call. If they have a call then they will be gone because the only thing different is that we had one down there 24/7 and we had another one out over here. So now we are just going to take the people instead of sitting in the building over here we are going to have them down there. Again if they have a call they are going to be down there and take off. We are going to limit this as far as overtime down to very small amounts and I know Civic Counsel has also helped out on some of the manpower issues and stuff like that. The fireworks are paid for by Civic

Counsel. Most of this stuff was all taken care of by them. I just want to make sure that everybody knows that we are not dishing out a ton of money again. *Motion by Stark/Second by Elliott to accept the report. Yeas All./LAW DIRECTOR REPORT: Law Director Graves reviewed the legislation on the agenda. I would request a brief executive session tonight to discuss the discipline or dismissal of a public employee and on-going collective bargaining negotiations. Councilperson Stark asked I was made aware that there is going to be a public meeting as we speak at Amber Oaks, there are some people who are upset about Dollar General and apparently have a law-yer coming as well. *Motion by Stark/Second by Elliott to accept the report.
