

**MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL
SHEFFIELD LAKE, OHIO
July 8, 2014**

The regular meeting of the City Council was held Tuesday, July 8, 2014. Council President Rosso called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

PRESENTATIONS:

Mayor Bring submitted Officer Beese for appointment as part-time Officer to the Sheffield Lake Police Department. *Motion by McCullough/Second by Smith to approve the appointment of Officer Craig Beese as part-time Officer to the Sheffield Lake Police Department. Yeas All. Mayor Bring swore in Officer Craig Beese as part-time Officer for the City of Sheffield Lake Police Department.

Mayor Bring submitted Jerry Gillespie for full-time employee to the Parks and Service Departments. He advised also the union gave us the okay for us to do that. *Motion by Kovach/Second by Cizl to approve Jerry Gillespie for full-time employee to the Parks and Service Departments. Yeas All. President Rosso stated he is a very good employee and it is well deserved.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

MAYORS REPORT: Mayor Bring reported just to remind everybody that we have Community Days, the rides will start on Wednesday night/Thursday is parade night and Friday will be fireworks with a band. *Motion by Erdei/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All./**FINANCE DIRECTOR REPORT:** Finance Director Smith reported before you is the tentative Tax Budget for the fiscal year 2015 that maybe added to the agenda. As I have mentioned before this is really an antiquated system but is still required by the State of Ohio through the County. The nice thing is at this point it balances. *Motion by Kovach/Second by Cizl to accept the report. Yeas All./**TREASURER REPORT: None./SERVICE DIRECTORS REPORT:** Service Director Smith advised no report. Councilman Erdei asked I know the guys were out paving/patching the holes at Apples and I understand that they are covering it. But how about the end of the Bowling Alley is and instead of taking left where it was all asphalt; that little stretch about 75 feet from where that guy has the window place? Service Director Smith asked are you talking about the end of Community? Councilman Erdei answered yes that little spot there before you go around the bend. Service Director Smith answered we might have missed that, I will check on it. That is where we did the 30 foot extension and I will check on it tomorrow. Councilman Cizl stated Len I was asked today – there is a rumor that there is a tree service that was going to bid on the clearing of the ditch off Knickerbocker and Holl. I didn’t know anything about? Service Director Smith answered we don’t have an on-going bid at this point and time, we don’t have a fund source. *Motion by Smith/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All./**SAFETY DIRECTORS REPORT: None./LAW DIRECTOR REPORT:** Law Director Graves reported we have begun the process of bidding the Brookside Nature Trail extension and that project is moving along nicely. We are going to be ordering some additional park equipment from the Solid Waste grant that we have received and we will keep you apprised as both those projects move forward. He reviewed legislation. *Motion by Erdei/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All.

CITIZEN’S COMMENTARY:

Joyce Nicola, 218 Mariners Way stated the street coming in Abbotsford over the winter we got big holes and that is a very good street. I think they should patch it before the whole street is ruined. Another thing, I don’t know if the Law Director can answer this question but there is a house in the back I think it is 145 Pembridge and it is not owned by anyone and was sold I don’t know how many years ago but

it was sold supposedly to this guy and he financed it overseas. So here he is coming over and still renting it and he rents it to 5 or 6 different people and all the neighbors around there when I walk they tell me that there is all kinds of things going on. This guy doesn't own the house so what can be done about that. Law Director Graves answered somebody owns the house and if they are renting it out. Mrs. Nicola answered no he doesn't own it. Law Director Graves clarified somebody owns it, there is somebody out there who owns that property and if it is rented they have to get an bi-annual rental license so I will make the Building Department aware of that and they will be subject to inspection. Mrs. Nicola advised as I understand the 2 renters he has got in there right now are going to be moving and then he is going to try to rent it again and he don't even own the property so I think the city should look into it. Law Director Graves advised we will take a look.

Rosa Gee, 272 Gayle Drive stated the city this year had the crafts in the park for the children. It is a great event and it is really a great thing that the city is doing and all the donations that came in for it. To see the kids there and to see all that the women have done with this is real enjoyment and the kids will also be in the parade. So everybody please try to applaud those kids really good. Another great program going on over at the Community Center this summer has been the drama club, the children from the High School are the ones that are the mentors for the little kids who are going to be putting on the play of "Fiddler on the Roof" and these kids are doing a great job. You can't imagine how patient the High School kids are with all these kids. So there are two really wonderful things for the kids this year in Sheffield Lake and I would like to thank you.

John Aybar, 784 Sheffield Road stated two things; the last time we were in here we were talking about the water where you met with the Mayor's, where are we at with that? Mayor Bring answered actually North Ridgeville did some things on their own and so did Avon and we have not had another meeting about that. We did do some stuff on Holl – we camera'd that and we did clean that out. Mr. Smith and I discussed having a private contractor do the ditch along Idlewood to clean that out because we haven't had time to do that. So we are going to contact him. The other grate that was plugged up, our guys went over and cleaned that out. Mr. Aybar stated the one on the other side of Ferndale? Service Director Smith answered the south side – yes, that was all redone and vac'd out and the line was re-jetted from one catch basin to the other one on Ferndale. Mayor Bring advised the one gentleman was talking about under the bridge but we have to lower a piece of equipment down with a crane to get into that. So we have not gotten to that yet. Mr. Aybar stated the other thing I got is 2 days ago, the carni's coming in – pulling the manhole covers and dumping waste in the sanitary drain. Service Director Smith advised they have a procedure they go through when they come here – they

have 2 designated areas over by the Bowling Alley specifically the one that they dump in. The other was done in June which is over in the middle of the field which we built originally which is a gray water retention basin for gray water only – not sewage. That gray water is also pumped to the sanitary manhole which was finished today. Mr. Aybar stated I witnessed sewage coming out of their fifth wheel parked over one of your open manhole covers dumping in the street. Service Director Smith stated in the sanitary sewer. Mr. Aybar stated if that is the one that runs down the middle of the road that they got the garden hose running in now. Service Director Smith stated that is the sanitary – correct. Mr. Aybar asked they are allowed to do that? Service Director Smith answered yes. Mr. Aybar asked they can open that up and dump human waste in there? Service Director Smith answered it is a sanitary sewer, that is what it carries. Mr. Aybar asked that is fine but they can come in and open our manholes up? Service Director Smith answered we knew they were coming in and we knew they were going to do that – it is all pre-arranged. We check and we even put meters on the water hydrants at Shoreway so that all the water that is used during the carnival's paid for by CCC is also monitored and measured. Mr. Aybar stated I pulled a fifth wheel trailer for 10 years and they have a hose that you can hook on there and you can actually dump with – you could put that down in there. You don't just have it open and let that stuff flow out. Are you aware of what I am talking about? Service Director Smith answered yes you are talking about running a hose in there but we also have to maintain an air gap too. I believe we have been doing it. Mr. Aybar debated you are missing what I am saying – his trailer is parked and he is dumping raw sewage out right into the manhole. Service Director Smith stated that is where it goes and I can't really say anything else because that is sanitary. Mr. Aybar debated there is a hose that just drops down in there. Treasurer Woods stated he is saying a hose from the trailer into the hole. Service Director Smith stated I understand but in reality it is immaterial, it is in the manhole correct. You yourself said you saw it going in the manhole. Mr. Aybar stated I saw him parked over there dumping it in a manhole. Service Director Smith stated again a sanitary sewer manhole. Mr. Aybar stated that is why I am against these people coming into our city because they don't do things properly. That is not a proper way to do it and if you think it is. Service Director Smith stated it has been done that way for Community Days for the last 30 years, why all of a sudden is it an issue? Mr. Aybar stated because I wouldn't want my children or your children or anybody's children walking by and seeing human waste just falling out of that – there should be a hose on there. Service Director Smith stated it is a sanitary manhole sir and that is all I can tell you, it is a sanitary manhole and it carries raw sewage. Mr. Aybar stated then what you are telling me is if he put a little rim around that he could pull that manhole cover and just stand there and take a dump and it would be correct. Service

Director Smith answered no I am not telling you that. Mr. Aybar stated that is exactly what he was doing. Service Director Smith stated I am telling you they emptied their trailers in the manhole in the sanitary sewer or their trucks – they put their raw sewage in there and they have been doing it for 30 years and it is a designated manhole for them to do it and the gray water that comes from their showers is controlled also. Mr. Aybar stated I can see the gray water comes out, I can understand running that because you got the proper lid on there. Somebody has put a different lid on there since they done that – are you aware of that? Service Director Smith answered no. Mr. Aybar stated there is a lid on there now that has just got a few garden hose holes in the side of it. Law Director Graves answered we will take a look at this and we will see if there is a requirement that they use a hose and if there is we will enforce that. Mr. Aybar stated all I know is when you go into an RV Park it is required. Law Director Graves answered I understand but you are draining into a very small ground drain in an RV Park and this is larger. We will see if there is a requirement to use a hose and if there is we will enforce that. Mr. Aybar stated I think you will enforce it because your Officer said they can do whatever they want and that is what I was told by 2 of your Officers when I told them. Law Director Graves stated we will take a look and see if there is a requirement that they use a hose.

Ann Marie Woltman, 649 Sheffield Road stated I had a gentleman come over and do my ditch and spent a couple hundred dollars or more and now I want to know what the city is going to do with Levin's property across the street that has never been cleared and property next to me. Service Director Smith stated we will look into it.

Matt Harper, 4146 Holl Road stated you guys spoke about Idlewood clearing, are you also looking into clearing that ditch down Sheffield? Mayor Bring answered yes. Mr. Harper stated just checking and making sure. Mayor Bring answered we are going to do both of them.

Nicole Debottis, 384 Maple Avenue stated I have a neighbor that lives behind me that has a downspout and I am just wondering what the regulations are on this. From their gutter they have a long black tube pointed towards my backyard and my backyard has been flooding and I just moved in last November and anytime it rains it has flooded and we now have to put in a drain tile to channel the water back out to the ditch. So I am wondering what are the regulations – is she allowed to have this long black tube from the downspout pointed towards my backyard? Service Director Smith answered I answered that in an email to your mother correct? Ms. Debottis stated you said you looked at it. Service Director Smith stated I answered all these questions that you are asking right now and I put it in writing – no they are not violating any law and he has a right to do what he does. It is no different than the side of your house pointing to your neighbor to the south, both of your

gutters point right to their house and it is only about 10 – 12 feet away from the property line. It is no different, you have a civil issue between neighbors. That is not the reason that your backyard floods with water – it is a low area over there. As a matter of fact over on Maple his extension that he put on his northeast gutter runs out about 15 feet and then if you look at Maple you will see that it goes to a raven between him and what is actually a swale, between him and the house to the north of him and it runs to Maple. I did answer that and I spent time over there 3 different times during the rain/when it wasn't raining and I looked at it and I wrote a nice long email explaining that to your mom who was the one who was inquiring. So if she didn't get it to you I will be glad that email with you and get you the same information. Ms. Debottis stated how about the ditches, are they going to be cleaned in that area? Service Director Smith answered we are actually going to be working on the one in front of your house going south to Madison and cutting over to the big ditch. We are going to be working on that this year.

Kathy Debottis, 868 Lake Breeze stated I did receive your email and I did tell her everything you told me. You also did tell me that you were going to go out there and check because the way that drain comes out – it goes directly to her backyard and I think the folks behind her behind her have drain tile and I think it could be clogged causing that to flow into hers. Service Director Smith stated that is a possibility, there is several houses over there all have water. Mrs. Debottis stated I just find it very funny that all of a sudden it is flooding when the folks that lived there before had a beautiful yard. Service Director Smith stated what you are talking about is the day of the 12th we had 6 inches of rain. Mrs. Debottis debated it was prior to that – it was in November, any time it rains it floods. Service Director Smith stated I didn't hear about this until after the 12th, I went over there and my Building Inspector has been over there several times. Has Jon talked to you? Mrs. Debottis answered no. Service Director Smith stated well he has talked to somebody, whether it was the guy behind you or whatever. Mrs. Debottis stated I called him and told him about it and he said he would check into it. Service Director Smith stated he has told me he has been over there and I still myself went over there 3 different times and that is why I didn't answer you for several days because I wanted to wait until I saw the different conditions before I put it in writing. Mrs. Debottis stated the last email from you is that you would continuously check it with the rains. Service Director Smith stated I have been and I can tell you to the best of my ability, I do not believe one gutter is flooding her backyard, it is another issue.

Betty Smith, 4146 Forestlawn stated Len 3 years now you said you were going to dig that ditch to where it goes someplace else. Service Director Smith answered correct. Mrs. Smith stated right now there is a ditch and we had tile in front of my house and the house next to me and the empty lots on the other side of me – it is

just a ditch and it doesn't go anywhere and when we have these big rains it overflows and comes up quite a bit into my yard and goes across the street and it front of my house. Then to top it off the guy behind put down a downspout on his garage and when he first put it down he put the downspout into my fence where it came into my backyard. I talked to the Building Inspector and he wrote them a letter and they did put an expanding thing on it where they could turn it around and it faced towards the garage instead of my backyard. But I just noticed now that they have turned it back and they have a rock on each side facing it into my backyard. I have a drain tile in my backyard and all that water that comes down and goes into that and it goes out to that dumb ditch. I need to have that taken care of. I had so much water that my sump pump couldn't keep up with it and I had flooding. I took a picture of that drain tile but anyway I just want to know if this is going to be taken care of. Service Director Smith answered yes it is going to be taken care of but you have to understand I do the best I can with the men that I have. I have 3 guys to take care of the whole city and some of you will sigh and say that is not a big deal but there is 3200 homes in the City of Sheffield Lake. There is ditches and streets and let's not count the vacant lots. People who live next to vacant lots want us to do that. Mr. Smith advised her you have a problem over there and the problem is the ditch she is referring to runs north and south between her property and a wooded lot owned by another private individual. Her front ditch is tiled in, you have no ditch in front of your house correct? Mrs. Smith stated right. Mr. Smith continued and it is tiled but there is no service drains so it is at the end of Forestlawn/Marion and Mansfield and what I was going to do and plan on doing is digging that ditch across over to Community where it connects to Community once we got that freed up. We just haven't gotten over there yet due to the other issues that we have been dealing with. Mayor Bring advised just one thing – I sat down with Mr. Smith last week and we discussed a lot of these problems that Matt and you were talking about and our manpower is very short. My idea was to spend a little bit more money and we are going to probably have to hire outside contractors to get this done because we just aren't getting to it fast enough and there is just no if, ands or butts about it. So that is what our next step will be. There was a gentleman that did some stuff over on Devonshire and if you look at that – that is the gentleman that we are trying to contact to see if he will help us out and/or we will have to contact a couple other guys to see if we can get this done because I agree - it is not getting done fast enough. This is stuff we talked about 2 years ago and we have not gotten to it. We are going to get it done if we have to hire outside contractors – that is what we are going to do. Service Director Smith advised Mrs. Smith I will be glad to sit down and discuss this with you anytime if you want to come in.

Romolo Debottis, 868 Lake Breeze Road asked are we getting a new Dollar General on Lake Road? Law Director Graves answered that matter is in litigation currently in the Ninth District Court of Appeals. Mr. Debottis stated the only reason I was asking if we are – I noticed that they build 2 types of buildings; real nice all brick buildings and then what I call steel sheds. I was just hoping that if they do get permission to build there that we get the nice brick building instead of the steel sheds. Law Director Graves advised the proposal that was approved by the Zoning Board is a nice brick facing building – they made a number of concessions to try to work with the community but it is being challenged by residents.

Cheryl Redman, 327 Oak Street stated is there an ordinance on cats; outdoor cats at homes. Law Director Graves advised I was on CNN World News about our cat issue a few years ago. Mrs. Redman stated we have a neighbor that constantly feeds the cats and she has at least 9. We have spent thousands of dollars at our house to put a fence up to keep her cats out of our yard and it is not stopping it. I think your gentleman Jon has been by twice and the last message he left us was you probably have to put your house on the market, there is nothing more that can be done and we have that on tape. Law Director Graves advised in Sheffield Lake by ordinance you are not allowed to have more than 4 cats and that does not include litters of kittens. The problem you run into is when people keep them outside and they run free and there is also ordinances on the books about perpetuating a public nuisance. What we have run into in the past is these cats breed and pretty soon they become a large group and then people will deny ownership – oh, they are not my cats but they are feeding them. We decided several years ago that if you are feeding outdoor cats then you are not going to be able to deny ownership. So if you are feeding them then you are basically taking on ownership to those cats. But when they start denying they are feeding them we have to see evidence of that. The Building Inspector would need to come out and see that they are actually feeding the cats. Mrs. Redman stated so if I had a picture of 9 bowls of cat food on a porch – would that be proof. Mr. Mike Redman stated they had their garage door open and Jon made them shut it and so they open the back door of the garage and they all come in there. They all come in at feeding and they keep them overnight and we walk in the morning at 4:30 because we both have to be at work at 6 and about 5:15 every morning they trot out of the house into our yard and crap in our mulch. I don't know if you guys like to work in your yards but. Mrs. Redman stated I will start taking photos of the poop then. Law Director Graves asked what is the address of this property? Mrs. Redman answered 331 Oak Street, that is where the cats are and now she is feeding them on your property because she is now taking arms full of food and she is going into the woods and she is feeding them out there. Mr. Redman advised I tried to talk to

them the other day. I went up to them when I was going to work – I work at the Avon schools and I work a Church service there on Sundays and I said Jim can I have a word with you and he said I don't think so. So I told him well I think I am going to and I got in a shouting match because that is what it has come to. As I was talking to him he is just freaking laughing at me which p_____ me off even more as it would anybody else. So I need to have somebody come over there and talk to these people because I have talked to Jon and Jon says he has hands full like you said sir. This is out of hand, I mean to walk out there and try to work in your garden which we try to keep a nice home and have cat s____ (poop) is not a good smelling deal. We have been friends for like 6 years with these people, you know snow blowing and helping out and we had to build a \$4200.00 fence (cyclone fence) and then they come in. Then I had to build another fence from that out to the sidewalk – a three foot because of these cats just coming in. Mrs. Redman stated there is just too many. Mr. Redman stated they have got 3 in their windows, they just like to look out and check out what you are doing. These others that they feed that come into their home – they take them into their home. President Rosso stated as the Law Director said we will look into it and see what we can do. Mayor Bring asked don't they have the right to get a hard box trap and box trap those on their property – are they allowed to do that. Law Director Graves stated we don't really encourage the neighbors to do that. We have also had some success with the APL or the Humane Society – they will come out and start trapping them. Mrs. Redman stated if I could catch one, I would actually just take them to Love A Stray – that is what I would do. Mr. Redman stated we have nothing against animals like most people but it is really bad. This is the second time that I have been here and hearing everyone's complaints – I was telling Cheryl I feel bad coming up here. There is one other thing I think one of these ladies was talking about their downspouts – is that legal to have them up to your fence because they have that too – right up to my fence. Law Director Graves stated actually I don't think there is any code related to that but that would not preclude, that doesn't mean that you may not have a civil cause of action. You may have a cause of action against your neighbor if they are flooding you out or causing damages. I don't know if there is any code related to how far you can extend your downspout out. Certainly they can't beyond the property line but actually it is encouraged if I am correct to run your water away from the house rather than enter it into the storm system because that relieves the burden on the storm sewer system during heavy rains. So the more downspouts that aren't dumping directly into the storm sewer. Service Director Smith advised if gutters are dumping right outside an elbow on the bottom of a house the water is going to go around the foundation of the house and go straight down to the drain tile and unfortunately Sheffield Lake has a lot of older homes. Those homes don't have a sump pump or if they do they have a combination sewer or what they call

footer drain. A footer drain is a drain that is right there around the foundation of the house that goes into the sanitary, an actual sanitary sewer but it is outside taking rain water into the sanitary sewer which is illegal. So if we were to start going from house to house and doing that – you are forcing residents to pay a couple thousand dollars to get it fixed. Mr. Redman stated I am not worried about that, it is the cats with my neighbor. It is just the back and forth with it and then he has a come back and so on and so on.

John Aybar, 784 Sheffield Road stated not going to be hard on you this time. You remember the elderly lady that was in the wheel chair right on the corner of Ferndale and Sheffield who passed away a couple of years ago. I don't know who is taking care of her place. Mayor Bring answered her son. Mr. Aybar stated well he is feeding cats, she used to have cats there all the time I don't know if you remember. Service Director Smith stated Mrs. Guisti and yes I know what you are talking about. Mr. Aybar stated we just walked over there the other day looking in the garage to see about renting it from him, on the porch is a bowl of cat food. I don't think the dog warden will even take them anymore. So what do we do because the first time one crawls on my car. President Rosso stated the Service Director will send the Building Inspector over to take a look. Mr. Aybar stated they are getting out of hand, the lady up on the corner up at Sheffield and Lake Road – I don't know how many she feeds. She must have dozens of them. Service Director Smith advised I have actually had the Building Inspector over there on the corner.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Councilman Kovach advised this I could have presented during the Park Board, I did get some correspondence from Mrs. Prokay in regards to our upcoming picnic. She has given me this flyer which I am going to give to Kay to add to the minutes “Attention all Sheffield Lakers”, in preparation for Sheffield Lake's First Annual “Saturday in the Park/Summer Skies Fest” She is looking for a DJ who would be willing to donate his/her time for 6 hours. She is also looking for donations of the following items: kites and Frisbees and the projected date for this event is Saturday, August 23, 2014. She has her phone number listed – 949-7379. He continued Kerry and I are possibly going to be planning to add our second movie night to that event. As far as that goes I don't know why I didn't say anything about that during our Park Board meeting but the movie that we put on turned out as an outstanding program. I thank Kerry and his wife and the man in charge of the popcorn concession which was Mr. Erdei. We had about 100 people there; parents and little kids and what I am thinking what might be nice is for the next one perhaps we have an ambulance there for a little PR that night. Then if they have to leave they could go off on a run. Maybe a couple Police cars – now Shawn did show up and came in over by us for a little bit visited and they did patrol constantly. Councilman McCullough stated but he

refused to shoot out the light. Councilman Kovach advised we did have one minor problem but Kerry has come up with a solution to that.

NEW BUSINESS: *Motion by McCullough/Second by Kovach to amend the agenda to include Council#042 to the agenda. ROLL CALL TO AMEND THE AGENDA: Yeas All – Smith, Kovach, Wtulich, McCullough, Cizl, Erdei.

Councilman McCullough stated I think we really got to look hard at maybe next year with everything that goes on in July to possibly changing Council's vacation month to July instead of August. President Rosso advised we will look at it next year. Councilman McCullough stated the parade needs help on Thursday night so anybody who would like to assist in parade operation and some of it is as easy as just making sure kids stay back off the street fall enough so they don't get hurt. See Steve and he will give your name to his wife and she will contact you before midnight tonight.

Council#041 – SECOND READING – an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Statewide Ford Lincoln for the purchase of a Fire Department Chief's vehicle and the declaring of an emergency.

Council#042 – EMERGENCY – a resolution adopting the tentative budget for the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015 and submitting the same tax budget to the Auditor of Lorain County, Secretary for the Lorain County Budget Commission and the declaring of an emergency.
