GENERAL BUILDING POINTS

- The Ohio Department of Health/Department of Agriculture have concluded their quarterly inspections
- The Center concluded our hosting of Bicentennial lectures this month
- The Center hosted the Lorain County Auditor this quarter to provide residents the opportunity to discuss most recent tax evaluations of their property
- The Center advertised for bids to resurface the parking lot. Barbicus Construction LLC, has completed most work, with the exception of tar/crack sealing the joints. The City will re-install the parking bumpers. Project was completed under budget @ \$53828.01
- Repairs, prior to paving were completed by the City improving catch basin rebuilding and proper drainage in slow draining basins. Grease traps were also cleaned.
- The Center has been utilized recently for craft shows, with more scheduled through the holidays.
- The Center has several fund raising events scheduled, Breakfast with Santa being the first Saturday, December 5, 2015.
- The Center is scheduled to conduct the annual tradition of providing gifts, baskets, etc. to those less fortunate in the community December 14 through December 18, 2015.
- The manager of NE Office on Aging resigned, and has been replaced from a staff member from the Elyria office. They also replaced/improved the office furniture
- The City authorized/completed correction violations this quarter identified by fire inspection. They included elimination of extension cords and installation of dedicated outlets in office. A safe perimeter has also been established in the mechanical room.
- Strong rental activity for next year's summer months is occurring with most Saturday's and Sundays booked into September. We are concluding the year with strong weekend rentals and average winter interest.
