ORDINANCE NO. 37-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SUPERINTENDENT TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH BROOKPARK AUTO AUCTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING AT PUBLIC SALE FIVE VEHICLES OWNED BY THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD LAKE WHICH ARE OBSOLETE, NOT NEEDED OR UNFIT FOR PUBLIC USE AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Sheffield Lake has five vehicles which are no longer needed for municipal purposes, to wit:

- 1) 1993 Ford Pothole Patch Truck, VIN 1FDXH81E6RVA06185
- 2) 1996 Elgin Pelican Sweeper, VIN S8408S
- 3) 2001 Jeep Grand Cherokee, VIN 1J4FF48S8IL601432
- 4) 2005 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN 2FAFP71W65X159296
- 5) 2007 Ford Crown Victoria, VIN 2FAFP71W47X162538; and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent has obtained quotes from several Auction Companies and has determined that Brookpark Auto Auction would best suit the needs of the City of Sheffield Lake; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Sheffield Lake to enter into an agreement with Brookpark Auto Auction to sell these aforementioned vehicles at public sale to the highest bidder.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Sheffield Lake, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Superintendent is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Brookpark Auto Auction for the public sale of each of the above-listed five vehicles with the highest bidder after advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality for a period of not less than two, nor more than four consecutive weeks.

- Section 2. The Superintendent is hereby further authorized to place a minimum bid and/or reserve on one or more of the above-listed vehicles which shall be at least equivalent to the salvage value of the vehicles.
- Section 3. If a minimum bid equal to the salvage value of the vehicle(s) is not received, then in that event, the vehicles may be deemed as being unfit for municipal use and shall be disposed of by the Superintendent for the salvage value as he deems appropriate.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of authorizing the Superintendent to appropriately dispose of five vehicles of the City of Sheffield Lake which are not needed for public use, are obsolete, or unfit for the use for which they were acquired.
