

**Minutes of the Park Board
City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio
November 20, 2017**

The regular meeting of the Park Board was held Monday, November 20, 2017. Chairman Lewis called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS:

OLD BUSINESS:

Skate areas: Mayor Bring reported we had the pump track at Ferndale Park, we are going to leave that pump track up this year where we actually took it down last year. We had the intention of putting that ice skating rink on that concrete pad and then we discovered that it wouldn't work there so we ended up putting it in the grass. We figured there is no sense in taking down the pump track this year and then putting it all back together. I think what we are going to do is make the skate park, possibly at Guenther Park this year. We may put it back there, but we are not sure yet. Anyway, that is going to remain the same.

Boat Launch: Mayor Bring reminded I believe Pat advised you of the restroom grant and we did get that. That will go up this year, that is a matching grant so we should be in good shape with that.

Shell Cove Park: Mayor Bring advised after we did the deck and all of that, Mr. Hastings talked about doing some armor stone to protect that and maybe get some access down there. The intention is, as you can see in the drawing, is to put some armor stone down there, but eventually we would like to put a little pier there. This is just the first step of this process, we have to get the permits and all the things involved in that. We are probably going to do that next year. We just constantly try to enhance that area. We are still getting people, even though it is cold now, still going down and standing on that deck looking at the lake. I saw some photographers there yesterday. [Shellcove Armor.pdf](#)

Guenther Park: Mayor Bring reported above, possible skate park here. I am still looking at possibly putting a small fence up along the parking lot next year. I did get a quote and I think it was like \$5000.00 but we didn't want to spend that though.

Covered Bridge/Trail: Mayor Bring reported the Bike Trail and the Covered Bridge, we are going to change the route of the creek where it makes that bend just past the bridge walking south. We are going to straighten that out. One of our guys actually put concrete barriers there to kind of shore that thing up. We are going to cover that with dirt and make that look a little bit better because it looks hideous and driving me nuts. So, the dirt we take out to move that over, we are going to fill that in and make that look a lot better. He explained the process to kind of straighten it out. That was all caving in because the creek was washing that out. But one of the guys just stacked it there, just didn't do a good job. It looks terrible, so we are going to restack that a little bit and take the dirt from over here and put it on top of that. Then I am going to get a company to go along the creek there where there is a lot of debris there, we are going to grind all of that up, remove all of that and clean it all up next year too. Then possibly look at putting flowering trees there and make it look a lot better. Right now, it looks pretty bad. We had a tree service go down there where an ash tree had fallen across the creek and was blocking, so we had them remove that. There is still quite a bit of debris there, it doesn't look good.

Lakewood Beach Park: Mayor Bring advised the condominiums were allowed access through the park for work they were doing. They finished their project down there so that has been all put back together.

Ferndale Park: Mayor Bring reported the cameras over there, we are still waiting for the electric company. They keep promising that they are going to get over there and so far they have not shown up, but we did have some storms and other weather related things going on. I am sure they were running around with all of that. But as soon as they get the power hooked up there we will have active cameras over there.

Freedom Park: **None.**

Gary Green Park: **None.**

Memorial Park: Mayor Bring advised you guys did the flag burning right? Member Gee answered yes, we did, we couldn't get the electricity on but we got by though. Mayor Bring advised that was the night I had the flu and couldn't make it. He advised so they did have the Flag burning there at the park. Member Kovach added Flag Retiring. Member Gee advised you can bury them or burn them and we burn them.
