Finance Director Smith advised yes, they have been purchased by another group of people and they have the Circus now with performers but no longer any animals at all. I guess they have gotten fantastic reviews with people loving it everywhere they have been they have sold out. Mayor Bring advised so that is going to be August 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> as we said we will try that and hopefully we won't have any protestors or anything and all should go well. That is when they were here before and they want to keep that rhythm going. Mayor Bring advised it is going to be one thing after another. Then obviously over in Shoreway fell through, the Laundromat and we had 3 other people looking at the space and one of the girls who want to do hair care. This is more for the younger crowd and she approached us and she would like to sign a lease. So, that will be coming to you at the next Council meeting. I would like to get that space filled and she has already got a cliental and lives in the neighborhood. I had a pretty lengthy conversation with her on everything that we require and she is actually very well prepared. So, I have got some pretty high hopes for this young lady. So, that will be coming to you. Then obviously, nobody took our test for the patrolman, so we are going to approach Civil Service with an idea and see if they accept that. If they do then we are going to be moving forward

and see if we can't get someone in here to hire for that. Also, as I advised the Park Board last night, the armour stone was completed over there and I am sure Steve will bring that in his report over at Shell Cove. So, we are protected over there. We do have the bids out for the bathrooms and so far, nobody has picked those up. So, we will see how that goes. Right now, construction is very busy and the guys that are out there doing that stuff are swamped. I am not too surprised that we haven't had anybody come and pick up yet. Hopefully, we will get somebody in.

Councilperson Stark asked about some of the roads and I know some of the guys have been out to fix some of the potholes and I know the weather has not been great. We have had water and then we have had heat which causes issues but some of the holes that they are fixing, the stuff is coming up and it is like on the roads. Either way, we need to re-fix those holes or can we do something to get some of the asphalt because the asphalt that they filled it with is laying in chunks in parts of the road. Mayor Bring explained some of that stuff that they put down, they rolled it. I think because it was so hot it actually came up a little bit. I did notice that and I am going to talk to the guys about it because I was driving around. So, I did see pockets of that which you are discussing and I will have that conversation with them tomorrow. Councilman Kovach asked any action on the Day Care Center? Mayor Bring advised still having some issues as far as the permits. President Rosso advised this is really not open to the public but I will allow it. John Edwards asked does the Kelly Miller Circus have a new name? Finance Director Smith answered no. Councilman Cizl advised I emailed you and Pat about the 500 block of Warwick Drive, did you get a chance to look at that? Mayor Bring answered not yet. I told you I was going to do that today but actually I went to Dillewood and I forgot to go down that street but I will./**SUPERINTENDENT: None.**
