ORDINANCE NO. 21-18

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER FOR THE PLANNING DESIGN AND RECONSTRUCTION OF THREE SEWAGE PUMPING STATIONS AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, on November 28, 2017 City Council passed Resolution No. 71-17 authorizing the Mayor to apply for low interest Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Water Pollution Control Loan funds, sign all documents for and enter into a Water Pollution Control Loan fund Agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio Water Development Authority for planning, design and/or construction of wastewater facilities, specifically the reconstruction of three municipal sewage/lift stations; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sheffield Lake has been notified that it has been approved for the aforementioned loan funds to proceed with the project, estimated to cost \$965,390; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Officer has certified the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund #617 as the dedicated repayment source for the loan funds; and,

**WHEREAS**, the project is subject to competitive public bidding.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Sheffield Lake, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to advertise for and to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder, after advertisement for not less than two nor more than four consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the city, for planning, design and/or construction of wastewater facilities, specifically the reconstruction of three municipal sewage/lift stations (“project”).

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio, the emergency being the immediate necessity of advertising for bids for and entering into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the reconstruction of three municipal sewage/lift stations.
