

**Minutes of the Roads, Drains, Water, Sewer & Refuse  
City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio  
July 9, 2018**

The regular meeting of the Roads, Drains, Water, Sewer & Refuse Committee were held Monday, July 9, 2018. Chairman Cizl called the meeting to order at 7 PM.

**MAYOR/SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT:**

Mayor Bring advised I brought up recently about the recycling program and the gentleman in charge of that emailed me again, we are having a meeting tomorrow at 9:30 in the morning. I don’t know what they are going to suggest on the tremendous buildup of paper going there and I will know more tomorrow. The last time we met he said he said he was going to continue the program and two weeks later we get another email. Councilman Wtulich asked when is our contract up on that again? Mayor Bring advised next year.

***Pump stations projects*** – Superintendent Hastings advised we opened the bids up for the sewer project today and there was a substantial gap between high and low of about \$450,000 but they did come in on par with the engineers estimate. That is being tallied and will be sent to the Ohio EPA to secure the loan that Council has already approved and then we will order the pumps which are made in Germany. They have a

4 to 6-week lead time and they project should start in I would say September and they have completion by the end of this year. So, everything is working well on that **Road paving list** – Superintendent Hastings advised I owe a phone call to Griffith Paving who won our road contract. I have yet to do that since returning and I will be going over that with the Mayor before I make that call and that should begin here the beginning of August. A lot of money for the sewer project and we about fell out of our chair when the first bid came in at a million and we expected half of that. But it is a very tight market and we didn't get a lot of bids, everybody is very busy.

**Abbe Road** – Superintendent Hastings advised I also while I was gone got an additional \$450,000.00 acknowledgement towards Abbe Road from the Ohio Public Works Commission. Also, to that regard, I got an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for 2019 which I had mentioned the Mayor wants me to pursue Harris Road. I touched briefly with the engineer on that today but it was a big day. Councilperson Stark asked how is pot hole patrol going? Superintendent Hastings answered good, they did about 25 tons in my absence and they were out again today. The trailer did break down so there was a delay over this last 3 weeks but they have put down quite a bit and are still at it.

Chairman Cizl advised I had a complaint and I did mention it on Warwick Drive. Superintendent Hastings answered yes, I printed your email today. Chairman Cizl continued I noticed the curb is flipping and I noticed there was some repair there and I didn't know if that was on the pot hole list. Superintendent Hastings answered I will have to review it as I just printed the email today. Mayor advised I actually drove down there and what is going to happen eventually is it will all have to be torn out and redone. The one area over there is basically from people parking on that side. Chairman Cizl stated I thought it was garbage trucks. Mayor Bring continued but if you look there is no parking on one side of the street and that side is okay. The other side there was parking for all those years and I think that is the majority of why that happened. But it is not terrible but to be done right it would have to be all torn out. Superintendent Hastings advised truthfully, if you replace it, to the Mayor's point the drainage of that entire block has to travel all the way to Forestlawn as it is a terrible design. The homeowners who have basements don't have much opportunity to pump the water other than to splash it out on the curb, so running pipes down there would be a big advantage.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

*Ditch cleanings; Day Ditch by Holl/Shumaker Ditch – north of Richelieu, east side by Buckeye* – Superintendent Hastings advised (retention pond and ditch work for Belle, Brockley, Knickerbocker and Holl) we received notification from the State of Ohio in

my absence for the \$450,000.00 grant and there is a questioner to fill out which I will do in the coming week here and I mentioned that to the engineer as well.

*Lincoln Blvd; nature trail from Oster to Lake Road proposal/wetland study –*

Superintendent Hastings advised ODNR has not responded to that application.

*Rededication of Community Road behind Shoreway Shopping Center –*

Superintendent Hastings advised we found a typographical error on the official maps that go to the county and they are being corrected.
