RESOLUTION NO. **45-18**

A RESOLUTION OF THE SHEFFIELD LAKE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NORTHEAST OHIO AREAWIDE COORDINATING AGENCY FOR A TRANSPORTATION FOR LIVABLE COMMUNITIES GRANT AND THE DECLARING OF AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA) provides implementation funding through the Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI); and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sheffield Lake has appropriated matching funds in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00); and,

**WHEREAS**, TLCI implementation grants are used to support activities that facilitate and promote sustainable development, multimodal transportation, and complete and green streets; and,

**WHEREAS**, TLCI implementation grants support economic development through place-based transportation and land use recommendations, and connect these proposals with existing assets and investment; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sheffield Lake has an existing TLCI lakefront connectivity planning study created in conjunction with the Lorain County Commissioners, the Lorain County Metro Parks, the City of Avon Lake, the City of Lorain and the City of Vermilion; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Sheffield Lake will utilize TLCI implementation funds in furtherance of its current TLCI planning study to support economic development and promote multimodal transportation opportunities at the Shoreway Shopping Center District.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHEFFIELD LAKE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit an application for TLCI implementation funds in furtherance of its current TLCI planning study to support economic development and promote multimodal transportation opportunities at the Shoreway Shopping Center District.

Section 2. The Mayor is further authorized to commit local matching funds in the amount of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00).

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which results in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 on the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio; the emergency being the immediate necessity of authorizing the Mayor to apply for TLCI implementation funds for the Shoreway Shopping Center District.
