

**Minutes of the Safety Committee

Reports from Safety Forces:

Police Chief Campo – Police Chief Campo advised nothing going on. Mayor Bring advised we are a little bit short on manpower because we have a couple of people out. We are going to be maybe looking into another possible full-time Officer. Police Chief Campo advised there is one point next month that we will have 2 Officers out on extended sick leave and 2 out on vacation. If you have 8 full-time guys and 4 of them are gone, it is kind of difficult. I actually did a schedule somehow. Thanks to Officer AJ Torres, our retired state trooper who is working here part-time and is really helping me out. If it wasn't for him, we would have some difficulty so we are managing. Councilman Wtulich asked how about Dispatchers? Police Chief Campo advised we are good now but we are going to need another part-time Dispatcher. When a Dispatcher is on vacation, that is 6 shifts open for that week and our current part-time Dispatcher doesn't want to work 6 shifts a week. So, we are going to need another one. Other than that, I mean we have some criminal cases that Detective Kory is working on and making headway on and taking things to the Grand Jury.

Fire Chief's report – Fire Chief Card advised so far this year we are up to 258 calls. The CPR classes are filling up and we did certify the Police at the end of February. Police Chief Campo advised I think there are a few stragglers. Fire Chief Card stated so there might be a couple in this next one in April. The extrication equipment we got March 7th in service and mounted on the truck. I am still waiting to hear about the grant for the ambulance. That extrication equipment was \$59,008.90 and the federal share was \$56,058.00 and our share was \$2,950.90. My guys are supposed to be bringing those over to show them to you. They are also stuffing easter eggs for the Easter Egg Hunt. Chairman Wtulich asked have you gotten to use those on anything? Fire Chief Card answered no, we haven't had any bad crashes to use them but we have them. We will be doing training on May 16th out here in the parking lot as we have done before. So, we will have like 4 cars cut up and that is a free class from Howell Rescue Systems, the people we bought it from. Councilman Cizl asked

what time is the CPR class on April 23rd? Fire Chief Card answered they are at 6. Chairman Wtulich clarified that is at the Civic Center right? Fire Chief Card answered yes. Councilperson Gee advised they are doing one on Monday morning April 22nd too. Fire Chief Card advised yes for the Coffee Crew.

Committee went outside to view the new extrication equipment that the Fire Fighters demonstrated for committee.
