***Reports from Safety Forces:***

***Police Chief Campo*** – Police Chief Campo advised it is been pretty quiet other than there was a chase from Sheffield Village, who chased a car into our city last week. It ended up being 2 teenagers from Cleveland with a loaded gun in the car. So, that resulted in a gun getting taken off the street and the car did crash into a tree in a front yard on Lake Breeze but the car took the brunt of it. I have an Officer assigned to a theft from a local business of over \$60,000.00 and it is pretty extensive right now. So, he is working on that and we anticipate an arrest. Our cruiser is due in March which is what we are being told now. I also have a perspective part-time Officer who wants to come in and talk to us about a part-time position. He is a retired Lorain Officer. We will have the annual report ready and turned over to you for February's meeting.

***Fire Chief's report*** – Fire Chief Card advised we ended 2018 with 1,091 calls. On vehicle maintenance, we had the oil changed on 75, 66, 72 and 71 in the middle of December. This afternoon we had to replace the battery in 66. On the AFG grant, we ordered the equipment; the jaws, the spreader and cutter from the 2017 grant. I wrote a grant for 2018 for an ambulance and a new power cot/lift. So, we should find out if we get that in the spring. I will also have my 2018 annual report next month.

***Safety Director Bring*** – Mayor Bring advised our one Dispatcher that was out on maternity leave is back. So, we are pretty much back to full staff. The holidays went very well, just like the Chief said it has been very quiet, very uneventful. If I could pay this guy's to do nothing but their jobs I would be more than glad to do that. We have been very fortunate, not much activity here. I was here most of the holiday, popping in and out but one of the firemen showed me a new program that Lt. Brian Davis spent 3 months on. So, he is working on some new programs for the Fire Fighters over there. When somebody goes on overtime or anything like that, he has a spreadsheet for that. He changed a couple of the monitors over there and did a real nice job and tidied up some of the area by changing out a couple of the computers over there. I just want to thank him because he put a lot of effort

into that. It is just nice to see the guys stepping up and doing all of that and working on it for over 3 months, it is just really nice. Like Mr. Card said, 66 did go down with the battery but we have been pretty much unscathed with maintenance. We are pretty good with the cars, his vehicles. I am very pleased about that, we have done very little maintenance.
