**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS**

**MAYOR/SAFETY:** Mayor Bring states around the third week of this month Harris Rd is going to get grinded down. Route 301 will start getting concrete this weekend. Our new mini excavator came in today. Monday coming up we will open the bid for the used equipment. Councilman Erdei asks how is the maintenance on the vehicles we have purchased so far? Mayor Bring states it is going very well. We are waiting on a response on our second leaf vac truck. Councilwoman Gee asks can you go over the grand opening event at the skatepark? Mayor Bring replies a pro skater is coming, we have had many kids there with zero problems. Councilman Radeff states I have been

working on that and we have some skateboards and t-shirts and things to give out as prizes. I think the goal is to get people to use the park and have a way to earn money to put back into the park. Mayor Bring states it's nice to see all the young people over there enjoying themselves with no problems. If that continues, we can talk about expanding it. Law Director Graves states it has to be clean cardboard, if it has food residue, that is considered contamination.
