SEWER CREDITS/UNPAID CHARGES FOR TAX DUPLICATE:

5501 Lake Rd. #30 requesting a credit of \$365.54. Chairman Wtulich states it is for a spigot left on that has since been repaired. Member Kovach states according to the summary, Pat is recommending against it.

*Motion by Kovach/Second by Gee to deny the credit of \$365.54 as requested. Yeas All.

683 Devonshire Ave. requesting a credit of \$54.32. Chairman Wtulich states this is for a broken main water line.

853 Pasadena Ave. requesting a credit of \$81.48. Chairman Wtulich states this is for a main water line break under the house.

5263 Willow Lane requesting a credit of \$417.76. Chairman Wtulich states it's for a broken water line to irrigation system. System was winterized.

4995 Lake Rd. requesting a credit of \$159.08. Chairman Wtulich states this is a broken house line between the meter and house.

MAYOR/SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT: Mayor Bring states we are continuing to do ditching and it is going well. The paperwork for Irving Park has been filled out and turned in. The project next to the Shoreway Shopping Center should be starting later on this month. Since COVID, we have had a number of people that were not paying their water bills on time. That has now passed as far as the Governor has said. We have been issuing shutoffs. One in particular was very high, like \$1600. The lady came in today and paid. Supposedly, her renter said she had been paying it. The water department girls are now going through all the accounts and will find the delinquent ones. The lady who had the two service calls is still not happy and did call city hall and talk to me. I’m not going to take it off unless you guys tell me to. It’s her fault for not being there. We also had a lady complain about erosion when we cleaned out the ditch. The matting was never moved so there was none. We planted some grass seed, etc. there so she is happy now.

OLD BUSINESS:

5263 Willow Lane service credit- addressed above.

Lincoln Blvd; nature trail from Oster to Lake Road proposal/wetland study – Mayor Bring states this is still on hold.

NEW BUSINESS: Member Cizl asks the two trees just west of Lake Breeze, one is dead and one on the north is alive, is Ohio Edison going to do anything about those? Mayor Bring replies we are probably going to trim some of those trees. We will start at one end of town and work through. It is our responsibility. We are starting to get caught up now.
