MAYOR/SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Mayor Bring reports they are moving forward on the Community Rd. project but are probably not going to pave it this year as they are going to run out of time. Irving Park is moving along nicely. They will end up paving that this year. That contractor has done a really nice job. The engineering is being done for Lake Rd. That will be late next year or the following year. The water bill: we noticed today that all the commercial businesses with the stormwater utility; we charged everybody residential wise \$4.85, the commercial businesses were charged with the impervious ground. The new bills that went out this past month, it was \$4.85 for all the businesses. The girls went back 3 months to check and see if CMI had transferred that over to the new billing, and they did but it wasn't picked up on our end. So, this month these businesses are going to be hit with a good-sized water bill. They owe it, they just got a break for a couple months. Mr. Hunter keeps asking us to pave the other side of Oster along with him. He keeps saying he is going to pave it, but he has not yet. Our side is in pretty good shape, I don't think we are going to do it. Councilman Radeff asks does it need paved or does it need new sewage, etc.? Mayor Bring replies no, just paved. We are still doing the ditching and piping. That will wrap up soon though because we will start leaf pickup. We are down a couple people. One of our workers in that department came down with COVID-19. I called the health director immediately. He asked who had contact with them and there were two others, so they got sent home. Those two tested negative.

Councilwoman Gee asks is there an exact date for leaf pickup yet? Mayor Bring replies we have no idea yet.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lincoln Blvd; nature trail from Oster to Lake Road proposal/wetland study- Mayor Bring reports they are still doing the study on this.

Mayor Bring states the outfall by the covered bridge that goes out to the lake, we are probably going to reroute that. We are paying for water that is coming in there because the lake water is so high. Chairman Wtulich asks the guy who lives across the street, he is going to pay for the damage he did? Mayor Bring replies he okayed it then changed his mind and decided to get an attorney. Law Director Graves spoke with her and straightened it out. We may be doing some work in front of the covered bridge soon. It was in the works, but then I cancelled it for lack of money and now I think we will be alright.
