ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

MAYOR/SAFETY: Mayor bring reports as you can see in the annual report, some of the numbers have gone down. A lot of that has to do with the pandemic and people not going out as much. If you listened to the governor's report today, it said if they continue dwindling on hospitalizations, he is going to start loosening up some restrictions. Hopefully he will start with the restaurants, etc. The radio legislation on the agenda we have already applied for and it will not cost us any money. I have a Zoom meeting with the other mayors on it tomorrow. Councilman Radeff asks do you have an update on the number of cases we have had. Mayor Bring replies I do not. We had 24 last week. It's probably close to a couple hundred now. We average around 24-29 a week. One of local contractors here, Scott's Home Improvement, contracted it and didn't do anything about it, he was only 47 years old and ended up passing away. I would definitely take this seriously. *Motion by Gee/Second by Erdei to accept the

report. Yeas All. /**SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT:** Superintendent Hastings reports we have commenced the water line on Community, we did tap Lake Rd. We are complete behind the shopping center and are now by Easy Transitions. That project will go to Ferndale and stop. It will connect to new sewer lines there. The plan is to install everything and then conduct pressure testing and bacteria testing. Once that is approved, we actually go back and do the connections to the businesses. Some of the homes on Community date back to the early 1900's, so we suspect they are lead lines and will be replacing them as required by the EPA. We are mobilizing at Day's Ditch for a retaining wall. We had that material with the idea of potentially doing it in house, but since the watermain started late, our guys are focused on that. The mayor did authorize a local contractor, Concrete and More, and that came in at about \$49,000. Internally, we are doing Rowelyn, the storm sewer. Currently I am waiting on the pipe which is scheduled to be here tomorrow. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report.
