

**Minutes of the Roads, Drains, Water, Sewer & Refuse
City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio
April 5, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Roads, Drains, Water, Sewer & Refuse Committee was held Monday, April 5, 2021. Councilman Wtulich called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.

ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS:

MAYOR/SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Mayor Bring reports we have been doing the ditching behind Speedway. We are putting a 30in. pipe in. The reason it is not in yet is that it was back ordered. All the stuff we have been doing seems to be working very well for keeping the flooding away. We are looking at getting a street sweeper and that coincides with the debris and curbs/gutters. It is a couple hundred thousand, but we have some money that we have been putting away and we have some machinery we can sell. If the condos get the ok, we are looking at doing that whole ditch all the way over to the edge of the property where Sheffield Village and Sheffield Lake meet. This is something similar to Day Ditch. The backside of the ditch by the covered bridge, I think we are going to dress that up slightly, put some armor stone there. We have been doing pretty well with refuse. Someone brought up looking into getting another dumpster back here. We are going to look into it. We will probably have to have somebody monitor it. We got the road list together and right now it is at about \$400,000 and we do not have that. We will have to narrow it down and put it out to bid. We are continuing to patch potholes. We are also going to fill in the big ditch on Lafayette. With water and sewer, you guys know we have had a problem collecting the bills. We have restructured all that and it is going very well. Member Stark asks are we going to have time to repaint where some of the crosswalks are? For example, Thelma and Gunther. Mayor Bring replies Pat tries to do that in the fall. Member Stark states on Thelma, it looks like there must have been a leak by one of the fire hydrants. It looks like they put concrete down and some kind of plastic. Mayor Bring responds yes, that was on purpose. I had a conversation with

Columbia Gas about not cutting our streets without permission. They did a full depth repair. They also did it on Lake Breeze. Member Gee states I noticed at the 600 block of Dunny on the east side, someone was filling in their storm water. I don't know if they put pipe in, it was a resident. Mayor Bring replies I will find out. Member Gee asks with all the issues going on with us trying to get everything clean and our storm water out to the lake safely, have we done anymore on the 12-15 septic tanks still in the city? What about the one on Rowelyn or Dunny, is that one still around? Mayor Bring replies I think one of those is gone, but no, we have not. It is so low; it actually has to be pumped up. I will find that out. I last heard there were 6-8 left. Member Erdei asks when you think about getting the dumpster, are you going to have one just for tree branches, etc.? Mayor Bring replies we have that now. We have one for metal and one for tree stumps, branches. We have pretty much eliminated that one though because you can put your branches on your tree lawn, and we will pick them up. You just have to call and make an appointment and we will get them. Chairman Wtulich asks is Lake Rd. getting done this year? Mayor Bring replies no, next year. We did get the flashing lights for Walker Rd. with a grant. If it works well, we may put them on a few more streets. Chairman Wtulich asks all the cleanup on that outfall over by Lakewood Beach Park is all related to better drainage to get our water to the lake, right? Mayor Bring replies yes. We have to put a sign back up over there, the sign was stolen. Member Kovach asks any idea when the brown bag, leaf clippings pickup may be? Mayor Bring replies I do not but will find out. Member Gee replies I thought it was next Tuesday, a week from tomorrow.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lincoln Blvd; nature trail from Oster to Lake Road proposal/wetland study- Mayor Bring states the EPA is mandating we get a water control person. Specifically, just for that. I find it hard to believe every municipality has that.

NEW BUSINESS: None.
