ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

MAYOR/SAFETY: Mayor Bring reports with all the rain the other night, we didn't get any phone calls. We used to average 20-40 calls with heavy rain, but what the guys are doing out there is working. The police are going to start installing some of their equipment this weekend. The Morrow project has gotten most of their permits, so you will start seeing some action over there. We did get our mechanic back and he is doing better. We had an entry level opening for the parks dept., and we did interviews and hired a young graduate from Brookside, Blake Stocker. *Motion by Gee/Second by Cizl to accept the report. Yeas All. **/SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT:** Superintendent Hastings reports we are prepared for leaf season. Our new garbage not compactor, but similar in design, in our local parks truck, it helps with the garbage by manually lifting it in for the men. We can use that as well for the leaf program. Our plow trucks are being prepped. The plow we ordered is unfortunately not earmarked until 2022, probably summer. We will be utilizing Leak Seekers which is a leak detection program where they operate in the evening and use specialized listening equipment throughout

every water main, fire hydrant, etc. to identify water that is leaking in the pipes that doesn't make it to the surface. Sheffield Lake is at about 7% of lost water revenue, which is better than what the EPA recommended 11% is. That will happen in November, so if you see four wheelers and listening devices in the evenings. The city applied for upgrades to the traffic signal and pedestrian upgrades at 301 and Lake. That is through a TLCI grant. Hopefully we can coordinate that with the improvements along State Route 6. Councilman Erdei asks how is our salt situation, do we have enough? Superintendent Hastings replies yes, we have about 600 tons in stock, and I did call for the release of about 300 tons back in June and we are still waiting on it. Councilman Erdei asks and we are just doing intersections, right? Superintendent Hastings responds yes and stop signs and main streets. It is important to remember the city has to identify on my MS4 reports every pound of salt we put down. That is because of our proximity to Lake Erie and the pollution that it can create. *Motion by Gee/Second by Cizl to accept the report.
