

**Minutes of the Roads, Drains, Water, Sewer & Refuse
City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio
Nov. 1, 2021**

The regular meeting of the Roads, Drains, Water, Sewer & Refuse Committee was held Monday, Nov. 1, 2021. Councilman Wtulich called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

MAYOR/SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Superintendent Hastings reports we are doing some sidewalk work on the truncated domes. There are several dozen to have done in advance of the paving next year. The city did get confirmation on some additional grant funds from OPWC towards that project. We also have nearly wrapped up the acquisition of land/right of way for the culverts under Lake Rd. Wednesday I will be presenting to NOWACA for the project on the 301/State Route 6 traffic light and improvements. We are hoping to get TLCI funds, it is coming in at about \$400,000.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lincoln Blvd; nature trail from Oster to Lake Road proposal/wetland study-

Superintendent Hastings reports this has been and out and awarded. We reached out for the schedule but have not received it yet. As far as the roads and drains, the city started on the east end of the town working westward on a final sweep for potholes. We have closed up the drainage work we have done in our efforts to continue to close up ditches, etc. We stopped on Idlewood for the season. For leaf pickup, I anticipate a week from today for that equipment to really get out in the city. On refuse, we did get the new piece of equipment in the parks dept., and we anticipate using it as well for our leaf program. Mayor Bring states with the amount of rain that we have had, we are still doing very well. The only people complaining now about water are the same people who haven't corrected their problem. It is not because of the city.

NEW BUSINESS: Superintendent Hastings states I was contacted by the City of Lorain to discuss sewer rates between the two cities. They asked for standard documentation that we provide annually as far as our mapping of the sewers, any new sewers built and our annual report on the water quality. Chairman Wtulich asks are they trying to negotiate different rates? Superintendent Hastings replies yeah, we typically do 3–5-year contracts and they have passed, it is standard to reach out and start negotiating. Member Erdei asks do we still have a couple guys out? Superintendent Hastings responds just one.
