ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

MAYOR/SAFETY: Mayor Bring reports Friday the refuse went fairly well. We have one person who refuses to take his garbage can back. May 21st is Pride Day, if there are any volunteers or anyone who wants to come, you are more than welcome. At the open house, Mr. Radeff will be making cotton candy. The police chief and I have been talking about cameras that pick up stolen vehicles. They are about \$3,000 apiece and we are getting 4 of them. We will put two on Lake Rd. and two on Abbe Rd.

Councilman Radeff asks are those the same cameras that also tell you if there is a warrant? Mayor Bring replies, yeah, it goes to the nearest police dept. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All. / **SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT:** Service Director Hastings reports last week Gov. Dewine announced \$51 million dollars in grants for traffic safety projects. The City of Sheffield Lake was awarded \$681,000 to continue the connectivity trail. Construction is underway as far as utility relocation on Lake Rd. Telephone poles and aerial lines have been moved. Currently gas lines are being relocated and once that is done, our project has been awarded and we will begin. This will impact driving and there will be detours on U.S. Route 6 because of it. On Pride Day, we have coordinated with the library, and we will have a shred truck at city hall. Councilman Radeff asks for the connectivity, what is the ending spot? Service Director Hastings replies it is all in phases and this phase is from the covered bridge to the community center. Ultimately, the goal of the study was to do all lake front Lorain County communities. Councilwoman Gee asks for Pride Day, are we taking paint or tires? Service Director Hastings replies no tires and no paint unless it is completely dry. I suggest using the Lorain County Recycling Center. Councilman Erdei asks what are the hours of Pride Day? Service Director Hastings replies 8am-2pm. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All. / **FINANCE DIRECTORS REPORT:** Finance Director Smith reports the police chief has been looking at record management systems and has settled on one called Sun Dance. This year we would have to pay for installation and moving our old records over. I established a line in his dept. to fund that. This is a net zero change, so no increase to any budget, just some money moved around. Legislation is attached tonight. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All. / **LAW DIRECTORS REPORT:** Law Director Graves is excused.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Councilman Radeff asks George with Treadway called and said next week they are going to start something; did you hear that? Service Director Hastings replies they are doing a little earth moving. They got their NOI with the Ohio EPA. I did explain it could be at his peril if the final few things on the site review are changed, but what they are proposing would not be too impactful. Councilwoman Gee asks is there anything that can be done about vehicles driving on the Lincoln Trail? Mayor Bring replies I have it handled, I met with the police chief this morning.
