August 16, 2022**

This regular meeting of the City Council was held Tuesday, August 16, 2022. Council President Rosso called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

MAYOR/SAFETY: Mayor Bring reports we met with the various cities today about the Ford plant. There are numerous things to iron out and they want to get started. They want to do a storm water utilities for it and it needs engineering. They said they wanted to use Bramhall, which is our engineering firm. We may have to call a special council meeting for that. It depends on what happens in the next day or two. Councilwoman Stark says I know we talked about Lake Rd., and you went out and measured the bike lanes, but now that they painted the lines, it really does look like it's short. Service Director Hastings replies it is the exact same. Mayor Bring says the other thing they did is at the crosswalks they put a vinyl stripping instead of paint which lasts longer. It makes a thumping noise when you go over it, but I was told that will wear down. Councilman Erdei states I think that outside line to the property has moved in a little. President Rosso replies they expanded the road. Service Director Hastings says the

asphalt is wider, the traffic lines are exactly the same. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All. **SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT:** Service Director Hastings reports the city bid out the replacement of culverts under Lake Rd. in advance of the paving this spring and it was supposed to be done in advance of the paving. However, when the contract was awarded, the supply chain was such that we couldn't expect our pipe until late fall. Now that it is paved and the pipe is in, we will be cutting open State Route 6 at Elm and Lafayette to install the new storm drains as well as the replacement of water lines. There will be a 45 day detour. We are doing it in such a way as to not too badly impact Bi-Rite and Amber Oaks. We have our Ivanhoe project out to bid and expect that to be done this year. We open those the first week of September. We opened the annual bid today and the asphalt quotes came in higher than expected, but that is the climate we are in. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All. **FINANCE DIRECTORS REPORT:** Finance Director Smith tonight you have Council #049 which are appropriations. I would like to save about \$11,000 and pay off Shoreway this year. *Motion by Gee/Second by Kovach to accept the report. Yeas All. **LAW DIRECTORS REPORT:** Law Director Graves is excused.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Councilman Erdei asks did you hear anything about our flagpole at Memorial Park? Councilwoman Gee replies he was out of state for a few weeks, but I will check with him.

NEW BUSINESS: Councilman Radeff says Jeremy Griffore reached out to me and is interested in doing a hometown heroes banner. Mayor Bring replies he reached out to me. We don't own the poles and we checked with some of the groups like Amvets and VFW and the cost is pretty extensive. We declined it. Councilman Radeff says I don't think his intention was to have the city pay for it. President Rosso says they would first have to reach out to the utility company to get permission. Mayor Bring says I passed his email on to the police chief and it is a little more involved then just putting flags up. Finance Director Smith states I would like to note we have a new podium that was made by our woodshop, and it is beautiful. They hand painted it and did it so the grain stays the same.
