Notice of Examination
Full-Time Firefighter/Paramedic

Purpose: Public notice is given by the Civil Service Commission of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio of an open competitive examination to establish an eligibility list for full-time firefighter/paramedic in the Sheffield Lake Fire Department. The exam will be on Saturday March 23, 2024 at 09:00AM.

Qualifications: *At least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.

- * High school graduate or GED.
- * Valid Ohio driver's license.
- * State of Ohio certified 240 firefighter/paramedic at time of appointment.
- * Complete the Tri-C physical agility test in under 4 minutes and thirty seconds.
- * Present a current physical agility certificate dated within the last year.
- * Applicant's height and weight must be proportional with no physical impairments.
- * Vision must be correctable to 20/20.
- * Applicants are required to pay a twenty-five-dollar, cash only **non-refundable** fee payable upon receipt of the application.
- * A passing grade for the written exam will be 70%.
- * Applicants that pass both the written exam and physical agility test will be Certified by the Civil Service Commission.

Applications: *Applications must be made on a regular application form provided by the city and may be obtained at City Hall, 609 Harris Road Sheffield Lake, OH. Applications will be available from Monday February 12th until Friday March 9th 2024 between 09:00 and 4:00PM.

Only the following documents will be attached to the application;

- * Recent photograph.
- * Proof of U.S. citizenship.
- * Birth certificate
- * Copy of high school diploma or GED.
- * Copy of State of Ohio driver's license.
- * Copy of both firefighter/paramedic certificates.

The exam will be administered on Saturday March 23, 2024 at 09:00 at the Sheffield Lake City Hall at 09:00. Once the exam begins no applicant will be admitted.

*Education credit of five points will be added to a passing score of 70% or higher if applicant has a four-year BA or BS from an accredited college or university.

Experience: Five points will be added to a passing score of 70% for two years of experience as a 240 firefighter/paramedic
