Announcement of Examination

Public notice is given by the Civil Service Commission of the City of Sheffield Lake, Ohio of an open competitive examination to establish an eligibility list for full-time firefighter/paramedic in the Sheffield Lake Fire Department. The exam will be on **Saturday March 23, 2024 at 09:00AM at Sheffield Lake City Hall**

Qualifications

- At least 18 years of age at the time of appointment.
- High school graduate or GED.
- Valid Ohio driver's license.
- State of Ohio certified Firefighter II / Paramedic at time of appointment.
- Completed Tri-C physical agility test in under 4 minutes and thirty seconds, dated within the past year.
- Applicant's height and weight must be proportional with no physical impairments.
- Vision must be correctable to 20/20.
- Applicants are required to pay a twenty-five-dollar, cash only non-refundable fee payable upon submission of the application.
- A passing grade for the written exam will be 70%.
- Applicants that pass both the written exam and physical agility test will be Certified by the Civil Service Commission.

- Copy of high school diploma or GED.
- Copy of State of Ohio driver's license.
- Copy of both firefighter/paramedic certificates.

Bonus points will be awarded for:

- 10 Points Maximum
- Military service credit of 5 points will be added to a passing score of 70% or higher for honorable discharge. Attach DD 214 to application.
- Education credit of 5 points will be added to a passing score of 70% or higher if applicant has a 4-year BA or BS from an accredited College or University.
- Experience: 5 points will be added to a passing score of 70% or higher for 2 years of experience as a Firefighter II/Paramedic
